

TOOTH EXTRACTION POST OPERATIVE CARE

Bleeding A small ooze of blood is common for the first 12 – 24 hours. If bleeding is heavy or persistent:

1. Gently rinse out your mouth with cold water

2. Place a clean damp gauze pack or similar over the bleeding area and bite firmly on the pad for 20 – 30 minutes

3. Bed rest with the head slightly elevate.

If bleeding persists or is severe, please contact the surgery.

Bruising Bruising may occur as the swelling starts to subside.

Diet Your diet will need to be restricted to fluids and to soft foods initially. A gradual return to a normal diet is

recommended.

Difficulty These are due to the anaesthetic or sedation technique employed and should only be temporary. You may

find difficulty in swallowing, a sore throat, or muscle pains.

Discomfort Always occurs with varying intensity. This should decrease significantly after 2-3 days, reducing the need for

painkillers.

General DO NOT consume alcohol for at least 48 hours.

DO NOT smoke as this will lead to infection.

Infection Infection is uncommon following oral surgery and if it does occur it will show itself later (after 3-5 days) with

increase in swelling and / or discomfort on the onset of a discharge. Please contact us if this occurs.

Mouth Opening Limitation with mouth opening normally follows oral surgery and will pass as swelling subsides.

Oral care Oral hygiene is very important and promotes rapid healing and resolution of discomfort. Commencing 24

hours after surgery; gently bathe your mouth with warm salty water following each meal, morning and

night. A soft brush can be used to gently clean teeth in the area at this time.

Stitches These are dissolvable, unless otherwise advised.

Swelling This is quite a normal response and usually reaches its peak 36-48 hours following the surgery. It often varies

from one side of the face to another depending on the degree of surgical complexity. The swelling will

significantly start subsiding after 4-5 days.

Work Depending on the type of surgery and occupation, advice will be given. A medical certificate will be

provided on request.
